SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased, and the Chair recognizes Senator Kahle to close on his first amendment. Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I think a great deal has been said and I think Senator Nichol with experience has expressed it very well. I think we are treading where angels fear to trod when we start setting high minimums for salaries that we are not going to pay for. So I think that in order to get this good bill across with the rest of it intact and only those minimums out of there and that demand on that county board for a specific salary, that we have a pretty good bill. I would hope you would support my amendment and we could move the bill across and help the sheriffs of Nebraska. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Kahle amendment as discussed. All those in favor of the Kahle amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

SENATOR KAHLE: How many are excused? Four?

SPEAKER MARVEL: One, two, three, four, five, six.

SENATOR KAHLE: Well, we still have a chance, so I think we had better have a Call and get it over with.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats and record your presence. The Chair is going to suggest that we remain under Call until we get this amendment and one other amendment processed. Mr. Sergeant at Arms....Senator Murphy, Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Keyes, Senator Kahle, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Chronister, Senator Goodrich, Senator Barrett, Senator Newell. Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, have the committee amendments been accepted. Is this an amendment to the amendment, or an amendment?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, this is your amendment standing by itself.
