LB 748

CLERK: (Read title to LB 748.) The bill was read on January 15 and referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker and members, LB 748 is intended to declare the Nebraska Council for Home Extension Club to be a statutory corporation and so grant the council the powers and the duty of such a corporation. By doing so this would help the council and Extension Club throughout every county in the State of Nebraska. In checking the bill there are a hundred and nineteen such corporations already and unless somebody has some questions, I would move the advancement of this bill. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: I just have a couple of questions of Senator Wagner, Mr. Speaker, if he will yield.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wagner, do you yield?

SENATOR WAGNER: Go ahead, Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: If we were to declare the Nebraska Council of Home Extension Clubs a charitable corporation, would that then mean that that organization is exempted from sales tax?

SENATOR WAGNER: Yes.

SENATOR JOHNSON: And would it mean that the organization is exempted from property tax?

SENATOR WAGNER: I would imagine.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Now, are there other comparable organizations, Senator Wagner, I mean are there other organizations that are at this time so exempted that are quite similar in purpose as the Home Extension Clubs?

SENATOR WAGNER: Yes.

SENATOR JOHNSON: And what would they be?

SENATOR WAGNER: What would they be?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, do you know? Do you have some names or...
