CLERK: (Read title.) The bill was read on January 11. It was referred to the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee for public hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Kelly's Administrative Rules Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kelly, are you ready with the committee amendments?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature, LB 712 committee amendment includes the sunset clause. I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy, do you wish to speak to the committee amendments or the bill as a whole?

SENATOR MURPHY: Only to say that I concur with the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 712. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no.

SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? I think if we could vote a little faster we could get a little more done.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passed. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Kelly. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. Speaker, this bill addresses itself to the proposition of legislative oversight. I don't know how many bills each year we pass in this body and designate to someone who we do not know and who changes from year to year and give them the authority to alter that law by rule and regulation. We never come back to see what the net effect of that bill has been under those alterations that are brought about by rule and regulation.
