LB 913, 958

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passed. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move for the advancement of LB 913 to E & R initial.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion? The motion before the House is the advancement of LB 913. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passed. The bill is advanced. Next bill is 958 by the Appropriations Committee. There are committee amendments?

CLERK: Yes, sir. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 23. It was referred to the Public Health Committee for public hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by the Public Health and Welfare Committee.

SENATOR CLARK: And who wants to take the committee amendments? All right, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I will move adoption of the committee amendments. All the committee amendment does is retain the selection of the appointment of the members of the Board of Examiners for psychologists in the hands of the Governor as opposed to the Department of Health and I would move that adoption.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the adoption of the committee amendments? If not, all those in favor of the committee amendments vote aye, those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passes. The committee amendments are adopted. And now on the bill itself, 958, Senator Warner.
