CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Keyes moves to withdraw LB 948.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Chair recognizes Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: What do you want now?

PRESIDENT: You are actually physically withdrawing the bill now. Motion is to withdraw the...

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I move we physically withdraw the bill.

PRESIDENT: Okay. All right, all those in favor....any further discussion? All those in favor to withdraw...what is the number, LB....

CLERK: 948.

PRESIDENT: Yes, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the withdrawal of LB 942 (sic)? Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. LB 942 (sic) is withdrawn, and the motion was to cancel the hearing.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: And the hearing is cancelled, Senator Keyes. Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: And now I move that we put the rules and regulations back into effect. I would hate to operate with the rules suspended.

PRESIDENT: They were only suspended for that purpose so you can rest assured that you are back on those comfortable rules again. Okay, now we will proceed to agenda item #5, motion by Senator DeCamp, LB 535. Mr. Clerk, read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to reconsider the body's action in Final Reading of LB 535.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.
