

be, and to say, hi, my name is John DeCamp, I am running for blah, blah, blah, and they say, well, John, why did you do this on this bill or why did you do that, and then big old Clete Durr or somebody up there says, John, why don't we buy you a drink. Well, naturally even though I am inhibited myself about drinking, it's out...campaign time and you say, well, I might just have one, and so you sit down with the boys and discuss politics and maybe they buy you a drink. Under the old law, well, shoot you have got to sit there, write that so and so bought you the drink. The new law has a provision that this would be listed, for example, as an anonymous contribution, a very important part so that if somebody wants to give you \$5.00 or something without having to worry about \$400 worth of reporting and forms, you can accomplish it. Now what I am suggesting we do this morning, I am suggesting you put a green vote to revive 535. I am suggesting you forget, for example, that who sponsored or didn't sponsor Sunshine Commissions, anything else, just put a green vote on it, trust me long enough to go read that bill. Let's put it up here and if you have got some positive suggestions... maybe some other areas need to be corrected. I know I have talked to Senator Barrett and he knows a few things where he has some concerns. Maybe we could make an amendment or two there, but let's get the bill alive and see if we can't make this accountability system, the Sunshine Commission, the whole works, function a little better.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? No lights are on so that is your opening and closing on the motion to reconsider. So the question before the House is, shall your action be reconsidered on....shall LB 535 be reconsidered for Final Reading? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Well, I guess we will have to have a.....record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 6 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, and LB 535 is now before you. Reconsideration is approved so it is before you on Final Reading...you don't want to proceed this morning with it? All right. Whenever the Speaker puts it on Final Reading then. We are ready then for Final Reading, and we will all....while we are waiting for the members to get to their desks, the Chair would like to take this opportunity on behalf of Senator Keyes to introduce a friend of Ron Cope's, Senator Ron Cope's, Gary Keim, a state trooper, who is seated under the north balcony. Would
