LB 319, 738

Gary Keim please stand up? Gary, welcome to the Legislature. The Clerk would like to read a thing in as a matter of record. Go right ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Ag and Environment whose Chairman is Senator Schmit to whom was referred LB 738 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments. Signed by Senator Schmit, Chairman. (See page 714 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Is everyone ready for Final Reading? We are on Final Reading. All unauthorized people will leave the floor. Everyone is to be at their desks and we are ready for Final Reading. The Clerk advises me that there are a couple motions on the first bill up before Final Reading, so Mr. Clerk, proceed with reading the motions.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have two. The first is offered by Senator Warner. Senator Warner moves to return LB 319 to Select File for a specific amendment. (Read the Warner specific amendment as found on page 714 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the bill be returned for specific amendment. The only purpose of the amendment...Senator Schmit and I visited about it, is to make it clear what the procedure will be for sending printing to the corrections systems to be done. The language of the amendment is such that there is no question that they do all their internal printing as they have, and then it would assign the materiel division of DAS which now by statute, and there is statutory reference to it in the amendment, that they have the responsibility of forwarding printing that is appropriate for the corrections to do or is appropriate for some of the other state printing to do. It seems, I think in our visiting with Loran and I that there is a....desirable that someone is designated to channel the printing requests so agencies know where to send it to and that is the purpose of the amendment. I move the bill be returned for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as Senator Warner has explained I do support the motion to return the bill, and ask that you do so this morning.
