CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: I forgot it's on Select File now.

PRESIDENT:wait until Select File? It's all right with me, but whatever you....whatever you want to do. We....adopt the amendment now.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, we held a discussion about this the other day, and (inaudible) start it over again, I deferred to the Speaker.

PRESIDENT: I know, but I wasn't presiding so why don't you let me rule on it. Go ahead.

SENATOR WARNER: Could I ask a question of the Speaker?

PRESIDENT: Yes, proceed.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. Speaker, sir, we just returned a bill to Select File for a specific amendment and I noticed...I said, you know, it could be taken up on Select File. I assumed that was the procedure. But then I noticed we don't have Select File today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, if there is no objection that is fine with me.

SENATOR WARNER: What is fine? To take it up?

SPEAKER MARVEL: To take it up today.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay.

PRESIDENT: We can take it up right now then, because there is no....this is my point, there is no Select File today and if you want to take it up today, why take it up right now while we are talking about it.
