SENATOR CHAMBERS: I want a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Oh, excuse me, I misunderstood. All right, now the question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will see that all members return to their desks, and all unauthorized personnel and nonlegislative personnel leave the floor, and all legislators will register your presence. Senator Chambers, if you will let me know if you want to take votes or whatever...okay, roll call vote. All right. So we will wait until people get here and then we will take a roll call. How many are absent? Two. Senator Labeledz and Senator Venditte are the only ones absent, so everybody else should be in their places. Senator Murphy, will you show us you are here? Senator Koch. Senator George. Senator Beutler. Senator Johnson. Senator DeCamp. Senator Haberman. Senator Kelly, are you here? Senator Kelly, Senator Reutzel. Senator Clark is coming. Senator Kelly seems to be the only one. Do you want to wait for Senator Kelly then, Senator Chambers? All right, we will start with the roll call vote and Senator Kelly is the only one that is not here. Proceed with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was taken as found on pages 715 and 716 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. There is no need to raise the Call. We are on Final Reading. Everybody is supposed to be at your desks anyway. Just had to have the Call to be able to get people back to where they should have been all the time. Okay, we will go ahead then with...we will continue
