SENATOR FOWLER: I move that the bill advance. This is the funding bill for the first year cost of 223, which was just advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion to advance 228A to E & R for Review vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Review. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of 228A. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

CLERK: Very briefly, your Committee on Miscellaneous Subjects whose Chairman is Senator Newell to whom was referred LB 823 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments; 849 to General File with amendments.
