CLERK: 13 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Record your presence. There are, what, two excused? Senator Cope, Senator Fowler, Senator Schmit, Senator Johnson, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Chronister, Senator Haberman, Senator Barrett, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell, Senator Chambers. There are two excused, which means there are six unexcused. Five now. Senator Schmit, Senator Chronister, Senator Haberman, Senator Barrett and Senator Chambers.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Mr. Speaker, could we have call-in votes? It is getting late.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, is that your request?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes. Meanwhile, we are seeking five legislators. Senator Schmit, Senator Chronister, Senator Haberman, Senator Barrett, Senator Chambers.

CLERK: Senator Wagner voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chronister, will you please record your presence? Senator Chambers, Senator Barrett, Senator Schmit. Senator Fitzgerald, we are down to two. Do you want to proceed with the roll....Senator Reutzel, shall we go with the roll call vote? Is that what you want?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Yes, let's have a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to proceed with a roll call vote? We are down to one. Okay, Clerk will call the roll. The motion is the indefinite postponement of LB 619. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was taken as found on pages 725 and 726 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. What do you have to read in?

CLERK: Several things, Mr. President. Mr. President, your
