CLERK: Final Reading of LB 599.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 599 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 750, Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 599 passes. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 607.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 607.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 607 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 751, Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 1 nay, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 607 passes and the Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 636.

CLERK: Final reading of LB 636.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 636 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 752, Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 9 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 636 passes. We will now proceed on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk, with LB 658, but before we do, the Chair would like to introduce to the Legislature a group of County Board Officials up here in the North balcony from all parts of the state.
