LB 629, 635, 648

He is seated under the South balcony. Would Tom stand up? Welcome, Tom. Now would the members of the Legislature kindly come to the front or go to the rear, wherever it is, and let's get started. It is a quarter after almost. One fourth of the first hour is gone. Well, we are still waiting. We have got over an hour of Final Reading ahead of us. If you want to get anything done, why get to your desks. Would the Sergeant at Arms make sure that everybody is at their desk? All right, Mr. Clerk. We are going to commence with LB 629 on Final Reading. Proceed with the reading of LB 629.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 629.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 629 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 777, Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 1 nay, 6 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 629 passes on Final Reading. We will now read LB 635 on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 635.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 635 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 778, Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 635 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read LB 648 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 648.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 648 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 778 and 779, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.
