LB 618, 618A

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. Senator Cullan. Okay, the motion before the House then is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Now 618A. Senator Cullan, do you want to move the advancement of LB 618A?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, please. Move for the advancement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, all in favor of....Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Just one short statement before, we have got four minutes before we go out. I want to know how much this is going to cost, how much this is going to exceed what we did last year so that it will stay within the seven percent of the State of the State's message.

SENATOR CULLAN: Senator Keyes, it is in the fiscal note. I...

SENATOR KEYES: \$39,000 for one man, but how many, is that for every office or just the increases in the five judges....

SENATOR CULLAN: I believe it is a hundred and some thousand dollars but I am not sure of the exact figure.

SENATOR KEYES: Would you say that is seven percent more than we spent last year?

SENATOR CULLAN: There is no doubt about it, Senator. We are adding a new function and I think it is a need that needs to be addressed but certainly it is in excess of seven percent (Interruption).

SENATOR KEYES: Will this bill get the signature of the Governor?

SENATOR CULLAN: I haven't checked. I don't know.

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
