LB 876, 818, 604

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 876 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. Have you all voted? 876. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is 818.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 818 was introduced by the Retirement Systems Committee. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17. It was referred to the Retirement Systems Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: LB 818 was introduced by the Retirement Committee. It is identical to a bill which was advanced out of committee, I believe it was two years ago and it was on General File and it never got acted on due to lack of time. It deals specifically with a professional employees in the State Department of Education. Employees will come to the department from school systems and will be a part of the state school teacher retirement system. Some of those employees would like to transfer over to the state employee retirement system because there is somewhat more benefits under that system, not a great deal but it is a little more advantageous. They would like to be able to make that transfer without loss of the accumulated contributions in the school retirement system. We have a situation with the State Department of Education where people in the same department fall under two retirement systems and I think there is a little problem with morale because of that. This would allow flexibility so that those people that wish to transfer in the school retirement system may be able to do so. I would move that it be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, LB 604.
