Koch amendment to LB 733. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Koch, We have about three minutes left on the bill. Senator Koch.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, I would like a ruling of the Chair on this particular issue. This amendment was considered formerly and was rejected and I am wondering how the same amendment can be offered before the body again without a motion for reconsideration?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Stoney, I think the Chair will rule that you waived your objection by allowing the procedure to go on. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I would advise Senator Stoney that this amendment may be somewhat similar but there is a different substance to it than the first one we offered. I move to advance the bill as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Stoney, the Chair has been advised that it is not the same amendment.

SENATOR STONEY: Can you explain why it isn't, Mr. Speaker?
