SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 280. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 280. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 280 which actually become the bill. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator DeCamp, do you want to advance the bill? All those in favor of advancing 280 as amended to E & R for review vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of 280 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 346.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 346 is introduced by Senator Murphy. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 16 of last year. It was referred to the Banking Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator DeCamp's Banking Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, the amendments basically gut the bill and they are agreed upon amendments and my good friend, Senator Murphy will handle the amendments and the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I wish Senator DeCamp didn't. This bill is a modification of a bill that we adopted about two years ago to provide central filing so that purchases principally of grain at the time were the concern that were coming from foreign counties could be identified by having a central filing with the Public Service Commission. This has not
