SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kahle. Senator Beutler, no, he is excused.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye, Senator Venditte voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, announce the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of the emergency clause.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The emergency clause is adopted. Now do you wish to advance the bill to E & R as amended? The motion is to advance 893 to Enrollment and Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of 893. As soon as we settle this particular bill we have one, two, three, four, we have five left on the list. Have you all voted? Would you like to have another Call of the House, Senator Johnson? We are under Call. The board is still open in case you want to call in a vote. Have you all voted? Okay, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carries and the bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 646.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 646 was introduced by Senator Ray Powers. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 9. It was referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Mr. President, I understand that the committee amendments that are in the bill book were the wrong amendments and those will be withdrawn and alternative committee amendments which are on your desk are the ones that we will be discussing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the first motion is the withdrawal of the present committee amendments. Is that the motion?

CLERK: Well, the withdrawal, yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If there is no objection, so ordered. Now the next motion is the adoption of the committee amendments as distributed.
