SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, on page 780 and 781 of the Journal is the listing for the Committee on Committees report. We recommend that Mel Beermann, Environmental Control Council; Milan Bish, Highway Commission; Gloria Dinsdale, Nebraska Arts Council; Greg Eden, Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education; R. Jerry Hargitt, Nebraska Arts Council; Ronald Kelly, Agricultural Products Industrial Utilization Committee; Harold E. Kirkpatrick, Environmental Control Council; and Ed Narjes, Environmental Control Council, be affirmed by the Legislature.
