SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Beutler, do you want us to proceed with the roll call? We are missing Senator Chambers.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Chambers is the only one who is not excused, who is missing?

SENATOR CLARK: That is what I have been informed.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, why don't you proceed with the vote, Mr. Speaker? Please.

SENATOR CLARK: Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 845 and 846 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CLARK: Changing from aye to no.

CLERK: Senator Clark changing from yes to no. Senator Marvel voting no. 21 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment lost. It did not pass.
