SENATOR KREMER: Okay.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: That is correct, Senator Kremer, and that is the intent of these amendments.

SENATOR KREMER: Okay, my second question is this. If I understand what you are doing here, you are doing what I thought was already in the bill in my white copy amendments. Is this right?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, that is correct, Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: And you think it needs strengthening.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, I just want to make it absolutely clear, both in the statute and the legislative intent, that this is what we are intending to do.

SENATOR KREMER: Now did you move to adopt all of the amendments...all of your...you had about two or three of them here, in one motion?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: No, I have another... I have another set of amendments that is coming up later. These amendments deal only with this issue, Senator Kremer, and it would amend the statute...

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you. In that case, I will support Senator Hoagland's amendments to the bill because I agree with what he is trying to do. I thought we were doing it and, however, Senator Hoagland feels that we need to put a little bit more strength in what we intend to do, so I will support this part of his amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. The motion...there are two Hoagland amendments as I understand. This is the first one. The motion is to adopt Hoagland amendment number one. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on Hoagland amendment number one to LB 507. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Hoagland's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment's adopted. Now, Senator Hoagland, you have another amendment.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: My second set of amendments, Mr. Speaker, makes three changes in the bill. The first change that it
