LB 621, 742

SENATOR MARESH: Senator Nichol, on page 27 it already states that unborn young of animals and growing crops are excluded. Isn't that right? On page 27?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you reading from your Final Reading?

SENATOR MARESH: Yes. Final Reading, Senator.

SENATOR NICHOL: That is correct. It is in the Final Reading. However, this makes it more clear as to when the debtor has equity in those items, Senator Maresh.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt, Mr. President.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 742.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 742.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.
