SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 765. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lamb, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR LAMB: I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing 765 to E & R for Engrossment say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, LB 690.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no amendments on....I have E & R amendments on 690.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 690.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is Senator Lewis in the room? The Chair recognizes Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Senator Lewis and I, Mr. Speaker, have circulated a memorandum relating to 690, and in his absence I would move that we hold the bill over until we can work out the precise details of the....I'm sorry, Senator Lewis is here and I will yield the floor to him, Mr. Speaker.
