LB 749

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler to close on his amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: No closing, Mr. Speaker. I have made the point I wanted to make.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 749 vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Beutler. Record the vote.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 15 nays on Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Do you have any...are there any other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: No, sir. Mr. President, Senator Hoagland would move to indefinitely postpone LB 749. That would lay the bill over. Senator Nichol has a motion, however, to suspend Rule 7, section 3, so as to take up the kill motion today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol's motion is to suspend the rules and take up the kill motion now?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of suspension of rules for the purpose of taking up the kill motion on LB 749 now vote aye, opposed vote no. No, this is the suspension of the rules in order to take up the motion to indefinitely postpone today. Have you all voted? Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Ask for a Call of the House, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Record your presence. Senator Powers, Senator Kennedy, Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Warner, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Fowler, Senator Schmit, Senator Kahle, Senator Sieck, Senator Kremer, Senator Chronister, Senator Chambers, Senator Labeledz. Senator Haberman and Senator Goodrich. Okay, the Chair is authorized to take call-in votes. The motion is the suspension of the rules.
