SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Schmit moves that the bill be advanced to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. LB 601.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 601.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 601.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Keyes now has amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, Mr. Speaker and fellow senators, I bring these amendments in for just one simple reason. The City of Papillion found that when their Mayor resigned after less than about a year in office, that the head of the Council succeeded him. Now the Chairman of the Council was in his last year of his term and has to be elected again. As he goes now from the Council to the Mayor he has still three years to serve, and the people there thought that he ought to only serve out until the next election like it is in most places. So I move for the adoption of these amendments. That's all they do. It is a new section. It inserts a new section, section 1.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Keyes amendment to LB 601. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Keyes' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments?
