LB 681, 747, 748, 759

Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of returning the bill to E & R for engrossment say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is returned. We are now back on Final Reading. The Clerk will read LB 747 on Final Reading.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 747 commenced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators are to be in their seats on Final Reading. The Clerk will hold up on reading until they are. Okay.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 747 continued.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 893, Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 17 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The next bill on Final Reading, LB 748. The Clerk will read.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 748.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 748 on Final Reading. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 893 and 894, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read LB 759.
