

go further. I will take up all these articles I have read and they say, oh, fifty or sixty percent really do support it. Let's find out. As I say, just move to reconsider. I am not asking you to support it, and I will say this, if the poll shows, for example, less than fifty-five percent in favor of it, I wouldn't even support it. I would want to see an overwhelming majority of Nebraskans, a clear-cut majority, you know, before I would even support it, but if we put it alive, a week or ten days later, whatever, we should have some results and I think it would be something that we could kind of watch and, as I say, break some tension. So I would urge you, by legislative district, you would find out what the people in your particular district thought. I think nobody questions the credibility of a Joe B. Williams poll. I'd like to just find out on one of these issues for the first time, so without committing myself to support it one way or the other, I want to see it alive so we can find out some information. I urge you just to reconsider and see what happens.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, to have a poll such as Senator DeCamp is asking for does not require the reconsideration of this bill. If Joe B. Williams is going to be hired by whoever is going to hire him, he can go ahead and do that anyway and I don't think the Legislature's time ought to be wasted. Now it is very seldom that I will mention the amount of mail that I get on any issue but I have gotten more mail on this particular issue than any other one and it may shock you to know that it is complimentary toward me for offering the kill motion. I think Senator DeCamp's motion ought to be soundly and roundly defeated.
