Senator Beutler, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Wagner, Senator Simon, Senator Hoagland, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Cullan, Senator Nichol, Senator Clark. Do you want a roll call vote now? Okay, all are accounted for. Two absent. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 899, Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Ready for item #8. Raise the Call. LB 276.
