CLERK: 18 ayes, 5 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators are in their seats. All unauthorized personnel have left the floor. Please record your presence. Okay, there are three absent. Senator Kennedy, Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Warner, Senator Keyes, no, he is gone. Senator Beutler, Senator Barrett, Senator Wagner, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Hoagland. Senator Schmit, we are down to two. Do you want to proceed? Okay, the Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See pages 902 and 903, Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What was the vote?

CLERK: 18 - 25.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Lost. Do we have other amendments on the desk?

CLERK: Yes, there are several.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, to remind the body that the Committee on Committees will hold a hearing at 12:10 p.m. at Room 1520 down below.

SPEAKER MARVEL: 1520 down below. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I would move that we adjourn until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.
