SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is the advancement of 773A to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on advancement of 773A. Have you all voted? Senator Koch. We are voting on the advancement of the bill. Senator Koch.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 834A introduced by Senator Sieck... excused me, introduced by the Revenue Committee. (Read title to LB 834A.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten, 834A.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB 834A is a funding for the continuation of the Department of Revenue.
