SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, I am sorry, Mr. Speaker, but I have to contradict what Senator Keyes is saying. The fiscal note he should be referring to is on 712 and relates to \$20,000. This bill...this bill has an outside maximum expenditure anticipated of \$20,000 and it is uncertain that half or two-thirds or one-third of this money will actually be required because without some experience we have no knowledge of how many hearings will be held as these rules are issued, but if each of the rules were heard, it would then add a fiscal note of \$20,000.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the advancement of the bill. Is there any other discussion? All those in favor of advancing 712A to E & R for Review vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of the bill. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is Senator DeCamp in the room? The next bill that is up is 823A. It is by.....Senator Newell. Senator Newell, are you familiar with 823A which is the original property of LR 154 Committee?

SENATOR NEWELL: I can't say that I am.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Pardon?

SENATOR NEWELL: Does that go to my Committee?

CLERK: It did, indeed, Senator.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay, is that the....is that Ernie's bill on....

CLERK: Sure is.
