LB 817, 846

PRESIDENT: The motion is withdrawn. We will proceed then with the Final Reading on LB 817.

CLERK: (Read LB 817 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 817 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Has everybody voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 944 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 17 nays and approximately 11 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 817 fails to receive the majority necessary to pass the emergency clause so now we submit the bill for your consideration for, shall all those in favor for it without the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I am going to have to request a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: All right, a roll call vote has been requested. Commence with the calling of the roll on the vote. This is to consider LB 817 without the emergency clause. Proceed with the roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on pages 944-945 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 17 nays, 7 excused and not voting and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 817 fails on Final Reading. Proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with the reading of LB 846 on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 846 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 846 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 945 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 846 passes. Before we take up the next bill the Chair would like to introduce on behalf of Senator Tom Vickers, his son, Matt, who is under the South balcony. Matt is a student at Iowa State University. He is on his
