SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, okay.

SENATOR KREMER: What I am trying to do in my move to reject the committee amendment is to see that the reinstatement of these licenses gets fully paid for by the person that is asking for that.

SENATOR NICHOL: All right, thank you, Senator.

SENATOR KREMER: And it will not be left...and in answer to Senator Keyes again, Senator Vickers did answer him. We would have to go right back and get tax money to support the reinstatement of these licenses if we accept these amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer, you may close.

SENATOR KREMER: Well only to say there is about 700,000 of these licenses come before the department each year and that will give you some idea if we accept the committee amendments how much it will require in the way of an appropriation out of our general funds if we accept this amendment. I again move that we reject the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to reject the committee amendments. All those in favor of rejecting the committee amendments vote aye and those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Speaker is trying to get us to vote a little faster today, otherwise we are just going to call these votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to reject the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The committee amendments are rejected. Is there anything further on the desk on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson now moves to amend the bill and his amendments are on page 930 of the Journal.
