As a matter of fact, I think we are telling them that, look guys, we think you are pretty good but if some members of your profession do some things that aren't so great, then in order to make the rest of you look that much better we should make it known that you can be reprimanded and be reprimanded openly. It is true. Judges are people just like legislators or anybody else but we do have them on a pedestal and the reason they are on that pedestal is quite simple. They do know the law. They know the law very well. The question is, when they break the law in some fashion, no matter how minor, are they high enough up on that pedestal that they do not have to be held accountable for it? That very simply is the question. I urge your adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the Vickers amendment to LB 82. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Vickers, what do you wish to do?

SENATOR VICKERS: I think we may as well end the suspense. I would ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right, record what is on there and we will have a Call of the House. The motion, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will see that all legislators return to their desks. All legislators will register their presence. All nonauthorized personnel leave the floor of the Legislature. The House is under Call. For the information of the body, there are five who are excused and four more are excused until they arrive. So we have about nine absences at this time. Senator Kremer, would you let us know you are here. Senator Clark is here. Senator Marsh, Senator DeCamp, Senator Lewis. Here comes Senator Lewis. Senator Vickers, do you want to take call in votes?

SENATOR VICKERS: How many people are excused, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: Five are excused and four more are excused until they arrive. So you have got about nine absences. We are down to a couple more now. Senator Marsh and Senator... Here is Senator Marsh.

SENATOR VICKERS: I would like a roll call vote, Mr. President.
