LB 848, 939, 939A

SPEAKER MARVEL: ...if there is no objection, the bills 939 and 939A will be passed over and be dropped to the passover file.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. Chairman, I would like to ask a question. Passover file works....you can bring it back at any time. Is that the way it works?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The request has to come from the introducer of the bill.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The next bill, LB 848.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 848 was introduced by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. (Read title to LB 848.) The bill was first read on January 22 of this year. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Senator Newell's committee has committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, do you want to move the adoption of the committee amendments?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I would like to move the adoption of the committee amendments and I will briefly explain those. The committee amendments basically define the words "suspend", "cancel" and "revoke", and licenses must meet the Fire Marshal's regulations before applying for the liquor license, and there is some rewording of the statute to make it easier to read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to 848. Senator Dworak, your light is on.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. Speaker, I don't have a copy of those committee amendments. Are they in the Journal also?

CLERK: Senator, they are in your bill book? They were printed separately.

SENATOR DWORAK: I just looked in my bill book.

CLERK: They should be there. I will secure a copy if you don't have them.
