LB 769, 774

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. The final bill for the afternoon is LB 774.

CLERK: LB 774 was introduced by the Education Committee. (Read title to LB 774.) The bill was read on January 15 and referred to Education and advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, do you want to take the committee amendments?

SENATOR KOCH: I move for the adoption of the committee amendments and then I will explain the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 774. Any further discussion? All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? This is the adoption of the committee amendments. We still have another motion to....record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, in roles and missions a couple of years ago we defined certain kinds of vocational schools who would approve them. It has been brought to our attention that there are a number of vocational schools or organizations which offer education and instruction which are licensed and regulated solely by an agency of the federal government, and they do offer curriculum and it was brought to our attention that possibly that for us to have the Department of Education or in some cases the Postsecondary Coordinating Commission to approve these is redundant since they live strictly under the guidelines of the federal agency and the one in particular who brought this to our attention was the Aviation Division here in the State of Nebraska, the Department of Aviation, and those who offer that instruction. So it is relatively a very simple bill and I think it is important that we allow this to happen. I ask for the advancement of LB 774 as amended to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill as amended to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote
