SENATOR DeCAMP: Just a minor amendment to clear up any discrepancies or confusion in the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we are now on the DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments. The Chair recognizes....we are speaking to the DeCamp amendment. The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, it seems to me that now we are getting down to the point where we are hassling the bill. There is nothing in the bill there that says anything about interfering with peaceful assembly and I think this amendment is frivolous and does not deserve to be passed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, beings as we have made Senator Johnson happy, we have made Senator Hoagland happy. Senator Beutler doesn't say anything any more. The news media should be happy, because we are not going to take the cameras or rights away. Labor should be happy. So I say this is a frivolous amendment and I wondered when Senator DeCamp was going to get in the act. I knew he was just standing down there waiting for the opportunity to get up and have a compromise. John, where have you been all morning? Really, John, it has been such a beautiful morning. It is ten after eleven and you have said something. I am proud of you, John, not only you losing weight but you are learning control. So I ask you fellow senators I don't think it would hurt Senator DeCamp's pride or feelings too much if we defeated this amendment and I ask that we do defeat it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There will be no demonstrations. Senator Chambers. We are on the DeCamp amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I will be very brief, and I will just use this opportunity to tell Senator Kahle where I came from. I came from Omaha, Nebraska. I think jungles are located mostly in Asia rather than Africa, and sometimes when we attempt to be clever, we only succeed in being something else. I am not going to comment on Senator DeCamp's amendment other than to say that if it is adopted, perhaps we should amend it to say that no provision of the U.S. Constitution is intended to be violated in any fashion also.
