SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am going to ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Never mind. Never mind.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, announce the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 21 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion fails. Senator Haberman, what do we do with the bill?

SENATOR HABERMAN: I move to advance 605.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 605 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are advancing...the motion is the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Senator Haberman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.
