SENATOR CLARK: Yes.

SENATOR LEWIS: Then I don't want to talk.

SENATOR CLARK: Thank you, sir. Senator DeCamp, do you wish to close on the committee amendments?

CLERK: I have one other amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: Another amendment. All right, explain it.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson moves to amend the committee amendments to LB 276...(read Johnson amendment).

SENATOR JOHNSON: I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw this particular amendment, Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR CLARK: It is withdrawn. Senator DeCamp, back on the committee amendments.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I move the adoption of the committee amendments.
