LB 618, 618A, 765A

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 618 to E & R for engrossment. A machine vote has been requested. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of 618 to E & R for engrossment. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you want to take up LB 618A? Do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think the bill has been discussed. The motion is the advancement of 618A. All those in favor of advancing the A bill vote aye, opposed vote no. There is a motion to request a machine vote. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. What about LB 94?

CLERK: I have E & R amendments and that is all, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely. Oh, Senator Landis. The motion is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 94. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. I mean the E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis moves to advance LB 94 to E & R for engrossment. All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Senator Lamb, do you have an amendment to 765A?

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. Chairman. Since we put the emergency clause on the bill, there will be another year's funding from federal funds and that is the amendment which is on the Clerk's desk. It is an additional \$421,404 from the federal funds for the period July 1st, 1979 to June 30th, 1980. I have checked this with Senator Warner and the funds are available. No problem. I move the amendment be adopted.
