LB 765A, 655

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Lamb amendment to 765A. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Senator Murphy, your light was on, I am sorry.

SENATOR MURPHY: I just wanted to ask of Senator Lamb, you did say federal taxes, didn't you?

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, that is free money, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the Lamb amendment to 765A vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Lamb, do you want to move the advancement of the bill as amended?

SENATOR LAMB: I move that LB 765A be advanced to E & R.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you want to try 655?

CLERK: There are E & R amendments to 655, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, the E & R amendments to 655.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 655.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The E & R amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy now moves to amend the bill: Read Murphy amendment four on page 1009, Legislative Journal. That is offered by Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I believe we discussed this amendment on General File, and in checking with Senator Dworak, he agrees this is simply clarifying language because the bill now states that the first payment shall be delinquent 60 days or 50 days after the levy is made but there is no reference to subsequent delinquency of payments and this would clarify that those payments do in fact become due on the date of
