SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Murphy amendment to LB 655. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Murphy amendment to LB 655 as explained by Senator Murphy. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the Murphy amendment to LB 655? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy, do you want to move the advancement....Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Let's try one more bill, LB 793. Senator Johnson, do you have an amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson has an amendment to the bill that is on page 810 of the Journal.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is a bill that was introduced by Senator Keyes and relates to credit unions and I received a call from a credit union in Omaha and the caller said to me that credit unions have never been designated as organizations that can receive state monies and the caller said we would like to be so designated. So I went to Senator Keyes and I asked Senator Keyes if he would have any problem if I took his bill dealing with credit unions and added an amendment in which I said simply that credit unions could receive state deposits and he said, no. Now he is not here, unfortunately, today because his mother is in a serious situation, to verify the conversation. In any event, what the amendment on page 810 of the Journal does is to allow credit unions to receive state monies. Now at this time it allows those credit unions to receive state monies only to the extent that those state monies are covered by insurance either under the national...either administered
