SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is to place on General File notwithstanding action of the committee, LB 974. Those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. It takes thirty votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would like a Call of the House and a roll call vote, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Legislators record your presence. Senator Landis, Senator Cope, Senator Kahle, Senator Sieck, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Goodrich, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell, Senator Kelly, Senator Clark. While we are waiting for the legislators to proceed, first of all, as a guest of Senator Shirley Marsh it is my privilege to introduce Mr. Melvin Jenkens who is the Regional Director located at Kansas City of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights. Where are you sir? We may welcome you to the Unicameral. And in the North balcony from Senator Landis' district, 21 third grade students from Huntington Grade School, Lincoln, Nebraska, with two teachers. Will you...? They are right up there. Senator Haberman, Senator Kahle, Senator Goodrich. Senator Haberman and Senator Goodrich. As soon as we finish with this item Senator Keyes is calling a meeting of the Government and Military Affairs Committee underneath the North balcony.
