

right on target. I think we lose control of the bureaucracy when we start creating an agency or a department here above the bureaucracy made up only of bureaucrats. So I think this is a significant piece of legislation and I think this is a significant piece of precedent. Lord knows we need coordination among these agencies because I have had several situations where I have had a handicapped individual that just didn't quite fit into any one of the existing slots and I would go to the Department of Education and they would say, no, this individual can't be here and I would go to the Department of Welfare and, no, it doesn't quite fit our criteria so until I got this Coordinating Council together we were unable to resolve this difficulty, but I guess I don't see where we need to create another bureaucracy to get these department heads together to serve people. That is their job now. That is why we are paying them now. That is where the tax dollars are going now and if the existing system isn't working, let's not perpetuate the evils of it which is what we are doing with throwing money into this particular type of agency and creating a whole other layer of bureaucracy. So I support Senator Murphy's amendment and I would hope people on this floor would take a serious look at this...

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have one minute.

SENATOR DWORAK: ...and really consider what we are doing with this. This is not a small piece of legislation even though there is a small price tag on it and it is an existing situation. I think the precedent is serious.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel. The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. While we are waiting for the vote there were 29 students from Japan up in the North balcony from Senator Simon's district. Dr. John Herman of the Creighton faculty accompanied the group.
