coordinate. Now our problem isn't a \$32,000 new bureaucratic staff position to be enlarged through the years. Our problem may well be the heads of the agencies we have now who are already on the payroll and whom we are proposing to pay additional funds to. I don't know, maybe they are going to meet in Denver if we will pay the freight, but I think it is time that we take a hard look at agency department heads of this caliber who can't perform the functions we have designated for them now rather than expanding the budget in order to pay them per diem while they are already on the payroll. This is a little bit weird and I would ask the adoption of the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp voting aye; Senator Johnson votes aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting aye.
