SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Murphy amendment is adopted. Are those all the...?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to amend and I understand Senator Kahle is going to handle that amendment. (Read Koch amendment found on page 1028 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, will the Clerk give me that amendment again, please?

CLERK: Senator, it simply adds some statutory sections on page 7, line 26. Page 7, line 26.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, this is to repeal language in there that is obsolete and it is not needed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready for a vote on the...? All those in favor of the adoption of the Koch amendment to 773 vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt Senator Koch's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now do you want to advance the bill? Do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, I move the bill be advanced as amended.
