LB 680

The House is under Call. All legislators are to be in their seats. The motion before the House is the adoption of the Schmit amendment to LB 680. The House is under Call. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator George voting aye. Senator Carsten and Senator Clark voting aye. Senator Kahle voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the Schmit amendment to LB 680. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Powers voting aye. Senator Cullan voting aye. Senator Kennedy voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting yes. Senator Barrett voting no. Senator Vickers voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Will you please record your presence, Senator Kennedy, Senator Kremer, Senator Barrett?

CLERK: Senator Kremer voting yes. Senator Fowler voting no. Senator Wesely voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, do you want to proceed?

SENATOR SCHMIT: How many are excused, Mr. President?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Nine. All are accounted for except Senator Marsh.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, go ahead and announce the vote.

CLERK: Senator Venditte voting aye. 22 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, do you want to move the bill without the amendment?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I think Senator Sieck had an amendment to the amendment. I am not sure. Go ahead and move the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 680 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor, a machine vote has been requested, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.
