SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection to Senator Nichol putting himself in a precarious position? Senator Reutzel, do you want to move adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR REUTZEL: I did.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the Reutzel amendment to LB 733. All those in favor of that motion say aye, no, I am sorry. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Reutzel amendment to LB 733. Have you all voted? Is there anybody else in the room that would like to vote? Have you all voted? This is the Reutzel amendment to LB 733. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Reutzel's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, I move we advance LB 733 to E & R engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 684.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments and that is all I have on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of adoption of the E & R amendments to 684 say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
