SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have an A bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 789A, title read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 789A, is that right? To E & R for Review. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any other items on the agenda?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Vickers would like to print amendments to LB 789 in the Journal.
