LB 808, 874

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Senator DeCamp, do you wish to be recognized on the next bill?

SENATOR DE CAMP: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 874 was introduced by Senator Lewis. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 22. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, advanced to General File. There are no amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, this is kind of a clarification bill, relatively simple. It simply places into law what everybody thought was the law for...well, since 1965 and what has been the interpretation of the Liquor Control Commission and eliminates the handling of cash transactions by the wholesaler and the retailer. It has to do with coupons and all we do is say those coupons have to be mailed direct to the people that put them out rather than starting some new process of going through wholesalers here in Nebraska who are supposed to deal only with the liquor retailers. So move advancement of the bill. To the best of my knowledge there is no opposition whatsoever. As I say, the whatever commission, Liquor Commission supports it and it just clarifies what is the law, what we think is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 874 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, LB 808.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 808 was introduced by the 154 Committee. Senator Chambers is chairman. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17, referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File, Mr. President. I have no amendments on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh.
